Saturday - Downhill Races - Richard Taft Trail
Start: 10:30 A.M. - Women, then Men, followed by the Co-Educational Race.

Sunday - Slalom Races - Taft Slalom Slope
Start: 10:30 A.M. - Women first, then Men.

THE EVENTS

1. Fourteenth Annual Team Race for the Hochgebirge Challenge Cup - best three men's combined score determines results.
2. Men's Individual Open Races - Downhill; Slalom and Combined. Veterans are defined as men age 35 or over. Some competitors may be scored in all three of the team, individual, open and veterans' races.
3. Veterans' Races - Downhill; Slalom and Combined. Veterans are defined as men age 35 or over. Some competitors may be scored in all three of the team, individual, open and veterans' races.
4. Women's Races - Downhill; Slalom and Combined.
5. First Annual Co-Educational Downhill Handicap No-Fall Race (limited to men age 50 or over and ladies who ski 30-ish plus). Handicaps will be determined at the starting line based on condition, morale and "birth certificates" of the competitors. This start will be just below the upper schuss on the Richard Taft Trail.
