SUBJECT: ANNUAL CONVENTION

The Annual Convention of the USEASA will be held at the Sheraton Ten Eyck, Albany, New York from April 28-29, 1956. Your hosts will be the member clubs of the Capitol District Ski Council.

By-Laws Article VII - Any member club failing to pay its dues before the time of the annual convention for the next fiscal year shall not be entitled to representation at the annual convention, and shall no longer be entitled to the benefits of membership.

Constitution Article VII - Annual Convention--delegates and alternates selected by member clubs from their own membership shall be individual members of the Association.

Only those clubs whose dues to the Association for the subsequent year have been paid prior to the annual convention and who have complied with club membership under Article III shall be eligible to seat delegates and alternates. Representation at the convention shall be on the following basis. Each member club shall be entitled to one delegate and alternate. Clubs having not less than 40 individual members of the Association shall be entitled to two delegates and alternates. Clubs having 65 or more individual members of the Association shall be entitled to three delegates and alternates, which shall be the maximum representation of any one member club.

The Ski Club Hochelivige ski club is entitled to 3 delegates and 3 alternates.
