

Hochie Ski Cup To Dartmouth; Linher Victor

FRANCONIA, N. H., March 4
Dartmouth's varsity ski team regained possession of the Ski Club Hochgebirge Challenge Cup, while Otto Linher, stocky young Austrian ski pro, and Mrs. Ann Jones, wife of Middlebury's women's ski team coach, completed clean sweeps for individual honors in the concluding slalom event of the 17th annual Hochgebirge meet on wind-buffed, snow-shrouded Cannon Mountain today.

With Colin Stewart, Billy Beck and Fred Barstow finishing fourth, fifth and eighth respectively, the Dartmouth squad added the slalom team title to yesterday's downhill victory to take the cup for the seventh time.

VETERANS' LEADERS
Linher, victor in yesterday's downhill, won today's slalom and with it the combined title by covering a 53-gate slalom on the Paulie's Folly course in 66.8 seconds for an eyelash victory over his fellow compatriot, Carl Fahrner of the Mount Mansfield Ski School staff. Tommy Corcoran, sensational Dartmouth freshman from Hanover, was third behind Fahrner to hoist the Green freshmen into the second team spot.

Mrs. Jones ran a shorter course in 52.6 seconds to spread-eagle an abbreviated women's field for all three titles.

Alec Bright of the host club won today's veterans' division slalom by a tenth of a second over Sel Hannah of Franconia, with Hannah taking the combined title on by virtue of yesterday's downhill victory over Bright.

CANNON FODDER
Today's weather was as rough so as yesterday's was gentle. Stinging clouds of mixed sleet and snow were swept across the course by gusty 45-mile winds. While visibility was tough at times, the driving snow kept the course in perfect shape throughout the long race.

The Hochie Club lost a fighting chance to pull ahead of the Green in this rubber encounter for the challenge bowl—each had held it six times—when Bob Livermore, yesterday's downhill ace-in-the-hole for the host club, injured his shoulder in a spill while skiing for fun after yesterday's race and was forced to withdraw.
